He is a very early foal born on 20<sup>th</sup> January which we hope will mean he is a precocious early type. The sire had his first crop of two year olds this year and they have done very well. He is a half brother to three winners and has a great page. He is a super looking horse and has got a great walk on him which is something you would like to see in your yearlings. After discussions with this year's members we have decided to again to run the syndicate with the members actually owning shares in the horse, not leasing as we have done in the past. As last year this will be limited to 20 shares only and will be sold on a first come first served basis. From feedback from last year's members it was suggested that we could perhaps buy this year a more valuable yearling with a view to having an equally if not better season than last year.

Because of this and to cover the expense the cost per share this year has increased to £1500 plus VAT this is a one off payment and will cover your share of his training fees for the 2014 season and yes you.... The Syndicate will actually OWN a share of this racehorse. As a member of the 'Moore the Merrier' 2014 syndicate you will experience the thrills of racehorse ownership for a full season. This includes race entry fees for maiden auctions, entries made thereafter will be taken from any prize money as would transportation costs for racing overseas. Apart from that there will be no hidden charges, just a great season to look forward to. Any prize money won will be paid out at the end of the season and be divided equally per share. Remember unlike many other syndicates this is the only payment you will make to cover your training fees for the 2014 season.
