


The Petticoat Government Summer Syndicate 2014

The Second horse is a 2012 bay filly by Indesatchel ex Darling Buds, the name 'Itsindebag' has been reserved for her, she is a really sharp, racy type with a winner's attitude. She is forward going on the gallops and we think she could likely be one of the first runners. A really likeable girl, she enjoys every day as it comes and is very willing in her work.

After the feedback from The 'Moore The Merrier' members last season we have decided to run the ladies syndicate in the same way, whereby the members will actually own shares in the horses. Membership will be limited to 25 shares only and will be sold on a first come first served basis.

Because the fillies are owned and to cover the expenses for them being in training the cost per share will be £1500 plus VAT this is a one off payment and will cover your share of his training fees for the 2014 season and yes you.... The Syndicate will actually OWN a share of these two racehorses. As a member of the 'The Petticoat Government' 2014 syndicate you will experience the thrills of racehorse ownership for a full season. This includes race entry fees for maiden auctions etc. any big race entries and fees incurred thereafter will be taken from any prize money as would transportation costs for racing overseas. Apart from that there will be no hidden charges, just a great season to look forward to. Any prize money won will be paid out at the end of the season and be divided equally per share. Remember unlike many other syndicates this is the only payment you will make to cover your expected training fees for the 2014 season.

We are really looking forward to an exciting season for the syndicate this year. As members you will have the opportunity to come to the yard to see the horses on the gallops at exercise and will be kept regularly updated on their progress as well as entries, declarations etc. made for them. Enjoy the excitement of race-days and see your horse run (badge allocation will be on a first come basis if demand exceeds the allocation) — an opportunity to enjoy the thrill of racehorse ownership at a fraction of the cost.
